Dear Family of Calvary,

Calvary will begin our return to worship in the sanctuary on Sunday, November 1, 2020. We will celebrate All Saints Sunday at both the 8:30 am and 10:00 am worship services. Our Annual Church Conference meeting will be conducted at 11:00 am. We will continue to provide weekly taped worship services on the Calvary website and Facebook for those individuals who are unable to attend in person.

As of November 1, 2020, the maximum number of attendees will be limited to 120, which includes staff/volunteers required to conduct worship services. In order to provide a safe environment for our members, the following guidelines **MUST BE** followed:

MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED TO ENTER THE BUILDING:

- If you arrive without a mask, one will be provided to you.

PRE-REGISTRATION:

- **PRE-REGISTRATION WILL BE REQUIRED.** To pre-register, please call the church at 717-545-0021 on Tuesday OR Thursday between 10 AM and 1 PM to make a reservation. Volunteers will be covering the reception desk to assist you with pre-registration. You will need to provide the number in your party, their names, and phone numbers. We may add online pre-registration in the future, but for now we will only accept phone-in pre-registration at these times.

PARKING:

- Parking will be available in the main parking lot (front) of the building and the handicapped accessible spaces on Locust Lane.
- You are free to visit with each other outside your vehicles while maintaining social distancing.

ENTERING CALVARY:

- You may enter the building 30 minutes prior to worship only from the main parking lot doors or the Locust Lane (portico) doors. Constitution Avenue doors will not be available for entry.
- Doors will be held open by volunteers in order to prevent contamination.

CHECK IN/TEMPERATURE MONITORING:

- Volunteers will be conducting check in and temperature checks for all attendees upon entering the building.

SEATING IN THE SANCTUARY:

- Certain pews will be closed off in order to provide safe social distancing.
- Ushers will seat attendees from the front to the back and dismiss from the back to the front at the end of the worship service.
- Family members who wish to be seated together should meet outside the church and enter as a family unit for seating.
- Pews will be sanitized between services.

WORSHIP SERVICE:

- **WEARING A MASK WILL BE REQUIRED THROUGHOUT THE WORSHIP SERVICE.**
- Worship service will be limited to 30 – 40 minutes.
- All core elements of the worship service will be available on the large screens.
- A one-page bulletin will be provided and we ask you take it home with you after worship.
- You may sing softly while wearing your mask if you so choose.
- Hymnals, Bibles, other printed information, and pencils have been removed to prevent contamination.
- Waving versus hand shaking will be used to greet each other while staying in your pew.
- The Cry Room and Nursery Care will not be available.
- Worship bags for children will not be available.
- Coat racks will not be available at this time.
- Once on stage, those leading worship will remove their masks to allow you to better hear them.

TITHES/OFFERINGS:

- Boxes or baskets will be available for dropping off your tithes or offerings either before or after worship services.

RESTROOMS:

- Attendees will be asked to refrain from using restrooms unless absolutely necessary.

ACCESS TO OTHERS AREAS OF THE BUILDING:

- There will be no access to the downstairs classrooms, fellowship hall, staff offices, or other areas of the building.
- Giant Gift Cards will not be sold during worship. If you would like to purchase, please call the church office to make arrangements.

If you are unable to comply with mask requirements or the above guidelines, we ask you to respect the safety of those attending by continuing to worship with us by viewing our Worship Services Online.
